KISUMU RECEIVES MILESTONE PROJECTS



H.E. President Uhuru Kenyatta, accompanied by his Burundi counterpart H.E. Evariste Ndayishimiye inaugurated the Kenya Shipyard Limited at the revitalized Kisumu port. The facility is one of the key game changers at the port and will open limitless opportunities in the maritime sector, including building of new ships and repairing the old

An SMS is then sent to the applicant with instructions and a link to access the Postal Passport Delivery Portal (passport.posta.co.ke), which provides a self-service interface.

REPRIEVE FOR NYAKINYUA FARM RESIDENTS

After more than five decades of waiting, there is a ray of hope for the people of Nyakinyua Farm in Kaplamai, Trans Nzoia East sub-county, after Dr. Fred Matiang'i directed the joint government team tasked with handling the matter to finalize the audit and titling process. The county government

recently disbanded the management of the farm over long-standing leadership wrangles and legal tussles. The multi-agency team now intends to fast-track a resurvey, audit and preparation of titles for the residents in consultation with the leadership of Trans Nzoia County.



DEAD END FOR AMAZON WEB WORKER PONZI SCHEME

DCI detectives have arrested Stacey Marie Parker, a 50-year-old American, in connection to the Amazon Web Worker ponzi scheme in which hundreds of gullible Kenyans lost millions of shillings. Ms. Parker is suspected to be one of the masterminds of the get-rich-quick scheme, which was executed through an app

packaged as the American multinational corporation. They then duped the victims to invest with a promise of high returns of up to 38.5%, which went up in smoke when the app and the website that hosted the platform vanished. The police were allowed by the court to detain the suspect for 10 days pending further investigation into the scheme.

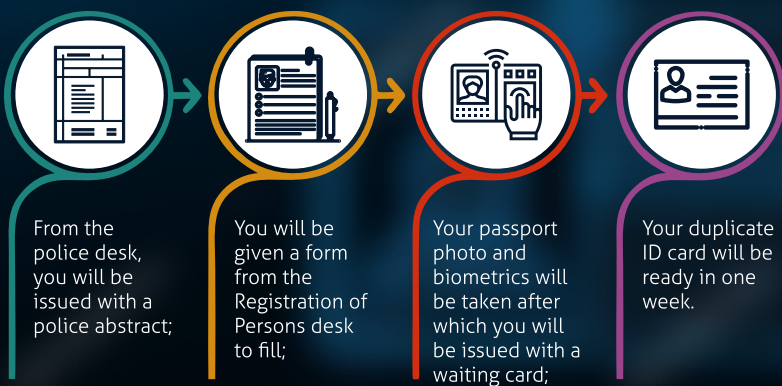
